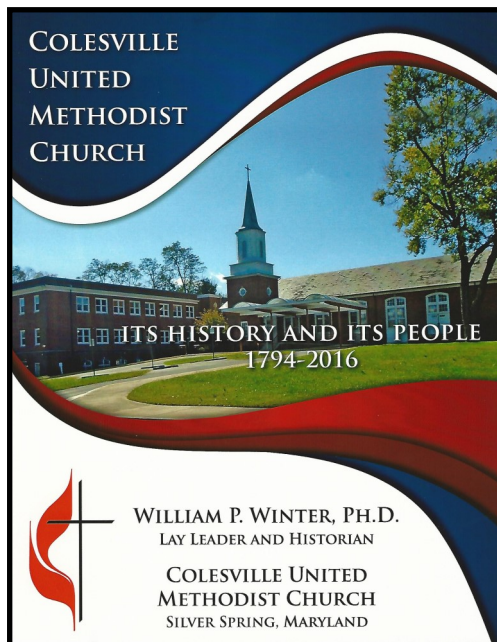


COLESVILLE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH: ITS HISTORY AND ITS PEOPLE 1794-2016
