

CDC COVID-19 Update

CDC has issued the following guidance regarding COVID-19 vaccine:

As of January 1, 2024, to be “up to date” with your COVID-19 vaccine, one must have received the new 2023-2024 updated COVID-19 vaccine. These would be the new Pfizer and Moderna vaccines that became available in September 2023 and the Novavax that was approved in October 2023. These vaccines are believed to be effective against the current variants of COVID-19. We are all urged to get these latest vaccines to reduce our chance to get serious illness from COVID-19. The earlier vaccines will not offer any protection at this point.

The presence of COVID-19 variants is still circulating and we all must remain vigilant and protect ourselves and those around us. We are all encouraged to continue to “Mask UP”. Make masking up a habit and be safe.
